



# PROPOSED PA ROOGA WIND FARM

## INVITATION - COMMUNITY INFORMATION AND DROP-IN SESSION

**You are invited to our next Community Information and Drop-In Session, to be held on Tuesday 9 September between 3:00pm – 6pm at the Prairie Community Hall.**

When we visited you in May 2025, we heard that you'd like to better understand several important aspects of our project, including:

- Visual and noise impacts
- Workforce influx
- Economic opportunities

In response to your feedback, we've been conducting a range of investigations. At our upcoming session, we'll share updates on the following topics:

- **Indicative photomontage** showing what the preliminary layout could look like from key locations
- Progress on our **workforce influx investigations**
- A **noise overview**, including how loud wind turbines actually are
- Our **local economic benefits & workforce participation approach**, which focuses on

working closely with the local community to maximise opportunities for residents and businesses

As part of this strategy, we'd like to:

- Conduct a **skills audit**
- Understand what **future skills** are of interest
- Understand the barriers that may have affected past tender success, so we can explore targeted training or qualification support

We have also made progress on our planning application, and will be sharing information on

- An early draft site layout
- Biodiversity and ecology
- Co-existence with current agricultural practices onsite
- Co-existence with neighbouring properties



## Community Benefits

We'll also provide an update on the **Queensland Government's new legislation** on Community Benefit Sharing. This legislation requires wind and solar farms to:

- Complete a **Social Impact Assessment**
- Enter into a **Community Benefit Agreement** with the local council (in our case, Flinders Shire Council)
- Formalise **financial contributions** during both construction and operation
